JIT, a term used a lot in manufacturing settings. I used to make stenography machines. You know, those funny typewriter machines used by the court reporter in courtrooms. Because businesses want to make and sell their products at the highest possible profit margin, they work real hard to have the production materials on-site just when they need them; not late, and not too early – "just in time."

God grows our relationship with him in a similar way – JIT. He uses all the trials, circumstances, relationships, good teachings and personal disciplines and causes us to grow. And what we've discovered (like so many other churches) is that he does this in the context of relationships. So as a church we cooperate with him and focus on making the most fertile setting we can for His divine life-changing work to occur – the small group setting, or what we call community groups. We feel that people (kids and adults) make the most progress when they are living in loving, authentic community. And adults in particular learn and grow best when they learn JIT. When that is happening, other good things tend to happen in conjunction with it.
