1. What are some ways in which we need other people? Is it possible for someone to really be a self-made person? Explain your answer.
2. Read Ecclesiastes 4:9-12, Psalm 133:1 and Hebrews 10:24-25. How have you seen the truth of these verses applied to your own life?
3. Why do people resist joining a community group or getting more involved with other Christians? Why might you personally resist getting more connected?
4. Can you think of an example where another believer really helped you? What are some of the dangers of trying to flesh out our faith on our own?
5. In Acts 9, Jesus reveals himself to Saul and, in the process, blinds him. This sets up the context for Saul to meet a believer named Ananias. Read Acts 9:10-20, 23-24 and 26-27. In what ways was Paul helped by other believers?
6. How might you apply tonight's lesson to your own life?
