INTRODUCTION

Angels and Demons—Part 6

Many misunderstandings come with the unseen world of angels and demons. While some have trouble believing the devil and his helpers exist, others give Satan too much credit for the difficulties in life. Misconceptions about God's angelic helpers also abound. We wonder whether we have a guardian angel, or if people receive angel wings when they pass away. There are so many questions—how can we know the right answers?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What are some tv shows, movies or media that have influenced your understanding of the spiritual realm? What are some things you have heard or learned from the shows?
2. What are some feelings that come to mind when you think about the unseen world?
3. Read Heb. 1:14. How does it make you feel knowing that God has angels to watch over us and minister to us?
4. What do you think it means that angels minister to us?
5. What do you think it means that angels provide for us? Guide us? Protect us?
6. Read Luke 4:5-12. What is Satan wanting Jesus to do?
7. Read Psalm 91:11-12. What is different in this verse than in the way Satan quotes it? Why do you think it is different? How does Jesus respond?
8. Read Colossians 2:18. Is it difficult to not worship the angels or unseen supernatural? Why or why not?
9. What were some things about angels that stood out to you during this message?
10. How can you apply this lesson to your life?

APPLICATION

We all have questions about angels—are they real? Do they affect us? Do they appear to people? Do I have a guardian angel? What is the role of angels? We all struggle to understand angels and how God uses them.

God uses angels in ministering to us, and angels rejoice because we put our faith in God. When we focus on what God is doing and how He works in our lives, we will see we are not alone in this world. We have God, the Holy Spirit, and angels to protect us in the unseen world. They're there to help us navigate life, and minister to us in times of need. Each one of us has God on our side—to protect us, watch over us, and guide us. We may not be able to see God, the Holy Spirit, and angels, or know when they're surrounding us, but we can be sure that they are there for us if we trust in Him.
