3. Read Philippians 2:5-11. What are some things we learn about Jesus from these verses? How might a leader (or king) with these qualities be the best kind of leader (or king)? Why is it important that we follow Jesus's example here?
4. If we recognize Jesus as our king, how will it impact how we live our lives?
